

Chad Fornoff has served as Executive Director and Administrative Law Judge for the Illinois Executive Ethics Commission since its creation in 2004. He has a staff of about 65 employees and oversees an annual budget of more than \$7 million. Since 2000, he has also served as an adjunct faculty member at Robert Morris University-Springfield, where he teaches paralegal, business, and humanities courses.

Previously, he worked as Legal Counsel for the Illinois Court of Claims and as an Assistant Attorney General in the General Law Bureau of the Office of the Illinois Attorney General.
