Frank J. Mautino was appointed by the 99th General Assembly as Illinois' third Auditor General in October 2015, for a ten-year term commencing January 1, 2016. Prior to his appointment as Auditor General, Honorable Auditor General Mautino was a member of the Illinois House of Representatives and served as a co-chairman of the Legislative Audit Commission. As a constitutional officer, the Auditor General audits public funds of the State and reports findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and to the Governor.

Sara Metzger, CPA, CIA has been the Assistant Director of the Illinois Auditor General's Financial and Compliance Division since January 2021. Sara assists the Director in general oversight of the division and provides technical review and guidance for complex audit issues. Sara started with the Office full time in December 2009 and has overseen the audit of the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report since 2017. Sara has a bachelor's degree in Accounting from Illinois College and a Masters in Accountancy from the University of Illinois, Springfield.

Courtney Dzierwa, CPA, CIA, CISA has been the Statewide Single Audit Manager since January 2021. Courtney started with the Office in 2003 as an Auditor I and has promoted to progressively more challenging positions during her tenure with the Office.
