Susan Haling was appointed as Acting Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor on March 14, 2018, and confirmed by the Illinois Senate as Executive Inspector General on May 31, 2019. Ms. Haling joined the OEIG in December 2011 and previously served as First Assistant Inspector General.

She has more than nine years experience as an assistant U.S. attorney in Chicago where she tried over 20 criminal trials. Ms. Haling also previously worked for the U.S. Justice Department, Criminal Division in Washington, D.C. Ms. Haling was a law clerk for the Honorable James F. Holderman, district judge for the Northern District of Illinois. Ms. Haling received her BA from the University of Notre Dame and obtained her law degree from DePaul Law School where she graduated Order of the Coif, served as editor for the *Law Review*, and was a member of Moot Court Trial Team.
